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## GUIDELINES CFNU BURSARY

### General Policies:

- 1) Any UPEI nursing student currently in year three (3) of a Bachelor of Nursing program or in their second (2<sup>nd</sup>) year of the accelerated nursing program may apply.
- 2) Applications must be received by the provincial office **no later than February 28<sup>th</sup>** of each year. Late applications will NOT be considered. Applications are available on the PEINU website ([www.peinu.com](http://www.peinu.com)) and should be addressed to the following:

- 3) Applications shall be reviewed and chosen by the Executive of the Union;
- 4) The successful applicant shall be notified on or before May 1<sup>st</sup>. Presentation of the bursary will be at PEINUø AGM held in the Spring.

### Criteria for Eligibility:

To qualify for the CFNU Bursary, the applicant must:

- 1) be currently enrolled at UPEI either in his/her third (3<sup>rd</sup>) year of the Bachelor of Nursing program or the second (2<sup>nd</sup>) year accelerated Nursing Program and be able to provide evidence, upon request, of such enrollment;
- 2) submit a completed application form, together with a one-thousand (1000) word essay on the value of being a member of a union.
