GUIDELINES PEI NURSES' UNION BURSARY

GENERAL POLICIES:

- 1) All PEINU members are eligible to apply for one of eight (8) \$500.00 PEINU bursaries. Preference will be given to those applicants who have not previously received a bursary from the Union.
- 2) Deadline for application shall be May 1st of each year. Late application will **not** be considered. Applications are available on the PEINU website (www.peinu.com) and can be submitted to the attention of:

- 3) Applications shall be reviewed by the Executive of the Union.
- 4) The successful applicant(s) shall be notified prior to the Annual General Meeting of each year and will be announced at the AGM.

CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY:

To qualify for the Union bursary, the applicant must:--

- 1) hold current registration and licensure as a nurse in the province of Prince Edward Island.
- 2) be a member of the Union.
- 3) provide evidence, upon request, of acceptance into an approved or proposed programme of study at the community college or university level in the health field on a full or part-time basis or CNA certification program.
