

16 Week Accelerated Emergency Nursing Program



PEI offers an accelerated Emergency Nursing Program (ENP) to support nurses who work in or are interested in working in the Emergency Department. Whether you would like to work in Emergency or are experienced in this area - ENP will develop your knowledge and skills in this nursing specialty.

There is a Two-Year Critical Care Area RIS for taking this program

The next ENP starts **September 3rd, 2024** and runs 16 weeks.

This program includes self-directed study of web-based lessons supported by a high level of interactive on-line learning using our e-learning platform Brightspace by D2L.

A study schedule and regular communication with faculty will keep you on track with your studies.

Learners take part in virtual classroom sessions as well as in-person hands-on simulations and skills sessions. Discussions and case studies that mirror the uniqueness of emergency nursing are woven throughout the program. Clinical is held on PEI at Health PEI Emergency Departments.
