Duties and Responsibilities of Vice President of Community Care

Policy Number II-83

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1. The VP of Community Care will:
 - a) serve as the liaison between the Local Presidents who represent Primary and Community Care areas and the Provincial Office.
 - b) frequent communicate frequently with relevant Local Presidents to identify site specific and global concerns across HPEI that impact members.
 - c) ensure that they receive updated local reports from their respective work areas prior to Executive Council Meetings
2. The VP of Community Care may be expected to represent members when the local presidents are not available.
3. The VP shall follow all duties and responsibilities included in Articles 3.05 to 3.08 of the Constitution and By-Laws and relevant Union Policies.
4. Qualifications and expectations for this specific role are further identified in the Terms of Reference document.
